High School Admission

- Siblings' admission starts mid-November (dates announced early November).
- Regular admission starts late November (dates announced early November).
- Admission depends on space availability. Therefore, we are only able to accept a limited number
 of students. Retaining the balance and integrity of class composition is very important to us.
- Waiting List and Late Admission applicants will only be contacted if places are available.

Admission Steps

- 1. Online application form is available on the school website according to the admission dates (Siblings, Regular or late admission).
- 2. Make sure to fill it out. It is important to consider
 - a. Writing the applicant name as required to appear on his/her certificates.
 - b. Applying for a sibling, it is essential to write the sibling's (currently in GVS) full name and current grade level.
- 3. Submit the online application form
- 4. Administration will contact applicants' parents to invite them for the interview and admission test on designated dates for each year group.
 - a. On the day of the interview/admission test,
 - i. application fees are paid,
 - ii. transportation form, consent to trips and fees forms are filled.
 - b. If an applicant does not show on the day of the admission test, the application will be placed as waiting list application. S/He will be ONLY contacted in case of vacancy.
- 5. Application fees are non-refundable.

Student's Assessment (Interview):

- <u>Date and Time</u>: Appointed by school administration.
- <u>Location</u>: The Green Valley School campus location (AlObour City).
- Duration: decided according to grade level and if a German assessment is taking place.
- <u>Terms of Acceptance</u>:
 - Applicant is assessed in English, Maths in addition to the student's personal interview.
 German assessment takes place in case s/he is studying the language.
 - o S/He is expected to score above 70% per assessment.

Parents' Interview:

<u>Date and Time</u>: It takes place on the same day of the applicant's admission test.

Assessment Results:

- All applicants receive an e-mail with feedback on their child's application status.
- In case of
 - o acceptance, parents have to proceed with the registration procedures mentioned in the acceptance e-mail.
 - Applicants who have been assessed and placed on the waiting list will be admitted where and when a place becomes available based on the following priorities:
 - ✓ applicant's performance in the assessments.
 - ✓ Siblings already in the school
 - o rejection, sitting for a re-assessment is not within the school policy.

Getting ready for the German Language:

- Knowledge of the German language is an advantage.
- It is compulsory that all newcomers attend the GVS German Introductory and Summer school course.
- Applicants with no prior knowledge of the German language will be able to join classes with German language support.

Assessment Terms and Conditions

- An invitation for assessment does not guarantee the offer of a place in school. It is possible that an applicant will be assessed and offered a place on the waiting list or rejected.
- School admission assessment papers are strictly confidential and accordingly may not be shared with parents.
- The school reserves the right not to disclose any information that it deems unnecessary with regards to the admission assessment.
