English and **German** are taught as a first language from primary till graduation; being partners with [Goethe Institute](#) we have many privileges. To name a few, our students are evaluated in Goethe annually, they’re given the opportunity to receive many scholarships and grants; inside and outside Egypt which enables them to become **fluent and authentic German speakers**.

Similarly, when it comes to **English** – taught as a first language, our students study at Levels from B1 to C1 on the [CEFR](#) before joining IGCSE; a journey that enables students to deal with English as a second language –an obligatory O'Level that students normally struggle with- with confidence and agility.

Through the voyage, students experience many hands-on presentations, activities and public speaking experiences that do not only result in fluency, but also enables the acquisition of [21st century skills](#) that distinguishes Green Valley school’s students and makes them easily stand out.
