School Campus Safety

- Continuous maintenance of all equipment and property takes place for the safety of students and staff at all times.

Science Laboratories Safety

- All chemicals are kept in lockers out of the reach of students. Lab assistant is responsible at all times.
- No student is allowed to the lab without teacher supervision.
- All experiments and/or lab practices take place under the supervision of the teacher

Playground Safety

- Supervision of teachers at locations during all break times to ensure safe play.

Internet Safety

- Safe connections with secured applications are installed to the school internet system

Emergencies

- Emergency Evacuation Procedures/Drills are held periodically to familiarize students with necessary procedures.

Safeguarding

- We believe that all students should enjoy school equally, and feel safe, secure and accepted. Bullying can be pushing, hitting, and spitting, as well as name calling, picking on, making fun of, laughing at, and excluding someone. Bullying is not tolerated at our school.
- Empathy and tolerance are developed at all stages.

COVID-19 Safety Procedures

- Cleaning and disinfection of school buildings, classrooms and particularly surfaces that are touched by many people (railings, tables, sports equipment, doors and window handles, toys, teaching and learning aids etc.) take place repeatedly during the day.
